As with past conferences scholars and postgraduates will have the opportunity to present research papers in parallel sessions. Such papers should be no longer than 20 minutes in length when read. Suitable papers will be published following the conference.

The theme of the conference is: Methods and Locations in Intercultural Theology and Interreligious Studies. Papers that deal with aspects of this theme are particularly welcome. Topics may include but are not limited to, empirical approaches to intercultural theology and/or interreligious studies; the place of disciplines like gender studies, history of religions, sociology of religions, cultural studies in intercultural theology and/or interreligious studies, and teaching intercultural theology and interreligious studies. We are especially interested in papers whose starting point is one other than Christian theology.

All paper proposals will be reviewed by the ESITIS Board before being accepted. Scholars and postgraduates who wish to present papers should send an abstract of no more than 500 words to: Professor Kajsa Ahlstrand, Uppsala University
