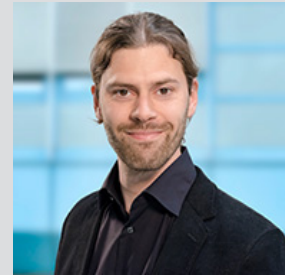


Participants

J.L. Schellenberg is acknowledged as one of the leading voices of contemporary philosophy of religion. As a native of Canada, he completed his bachelor's and master's degrees as well as a year at a Mennonite seminary between 1980 and 1987, studying at the University of Calgary in Canada, before moving to Oxford in 1987. There, in addition to his interests in the philosophy of religion, he studied continental philosophy (especially Anselm, Thomas, Kant, Schleiermacher, and Kierkegaard) and completed his DPhil with Richard Swinburne. In 1994, Schellenberg went to Mount Saint Vincent University, where he progressed through the ranks of assistant and associate before becoming a full professor in 1999. Since 2007, in addition to his work at Mount Saint Vincent University, Schellenberg has also been an Adjunct Professor in the Faculty of Graduate Studies at Dalhousie University. Schellenberg's list of publications includes 12 books and over 70 essays, like *Divine Hiddenness and Human Reason* (Cornell University Press, 1993), his Cornell trilogy *Prolegomena to a Philosophy of Religion* (2005), *The Wisdom to Doubt* (2007), and *The Will to Imagine* (2009) as well as *Evolutionary Religion* (Oxford University Press, 2013), *Progressive Atheism* (Bloomsbury, 2019), and *Religion After Science* (Cambridge University Press, 2019).
